'I began my career in a suburban law firm in Brisbane. It was a good grounding for me because I gained experience in a broad range of areas, including commercial law, family law, criminal law, defamation and insolvency. When I joined Barry.Nilsson. in 1988, I decided to specialise in family law. I liked it because not only is it about people, but you need to have a good understanding of commercial issues, especially trusts, property and tax. I suppose you could say that family law is interdisciplinary, because a good family lawyer understands how those other branches of the law intersect with it, and uses that knowledge to get the best result for their client.'

Geoff is extremely highly regarded by his clients for his ability to negotiate complex property settlements.

'I think what distinguishes me and my colleagues at Barry.Nilsson. from many other lawyers working in family law is that we're very pragmatic and don't simply follow the process. In addition, I approach every matter very strategically. I also make sure I treat everyone as an individual, because every case - every situation - I work on is different. Finally, I never sugar-coat an advice. I'm totally up-front with my clients. That's important in family law.'

Geoff is listed in the 2014 to 2019 editions of *Doyle's Guide* as one of Australia's preeminent family and divorce lawyers. He has also been recognised as a leading family lawyer for high-value and complex property matters.
